This keeps everyone safe – You, our staff and our community.

- **Everyone over the age of 12 is required to wear a mask while inside the clinic.** If you are unable to wear a mask we will be happy to see you in our clinical tent outside.

**Bonus:** If you are younger than 12 and can wear a mask you get an extra sticker! 😊

- **QR check-in** is required for everyone entering the clinic.
- **We require proof of vaccination status or medical exemption *at the time of booking* for face to face appointments**, for all clients 12 years and over.
- If you require a procedure that will take longer than 15 min\*, you will need to have a negative rapid antigen test on arrival. Please arrive 20 min before your booked appointment time. This way our nurses can perform your rapid antigen test and you can be seen on time. There is a cost of \$15 for the antigen test.
- **If you are unvaccinated we will be able to see you in our clinical tent outside.** Should your treatment require you to come into the clinic *you will be required to have a negative rapid antigen test* first. Please arrive 20 min prior to your booked appointment time. This way our nurses can perform your rapid antigen test and you can be seen on time. There is a cost of \$15 for the antigen test.
